Committee

Our management Committee is made up of parent volunteers who undertake a variety of roles including Chair, Treasurer, Secretary, Health & Safety, and Safeguarding. This year we are also introducing a separate Fundraising Committee to plan and run our events through the year. They meet each half term to review the workings of the setting and make key business decisions. The Committee raises funds to invest in new equipment and support the setting financially.

WE NEED YOUR HELP - This year our Treasurer and Secretary will be standing down, and being a charity, we <u>must</u> fill these roles for Stepping Stones to continue to open, so please ask if you are interested in getting involved.

Bags/coats

Children should wear a waterproof coat and bring a bag to Stepping Stones daily, containing spare shoes, such as trainers or pumps, plus a change of clothing including socks, and any other essentials your child may need during the day. Toys from home should not be included. It is essential that all items are clearly labelled with your child's name.

In the 'How you can help us' document you will find information about My Name Tags which are personalised stickers for clothing and possessions, and we have a special Stepping Stones code so that we raise some funds each time the code is used.

Christmas

I know we have only just come back but it is worth noting that our last day of term is Friday 19th December. As is tradition on the last day, we will be going to the village hall and the children will be performing a nativity show. After the show there will be a picnic lunch for the children and refreshments available to buy. All children are invited, including those who do not usually attend on a Friday. It is a much-loved event in the annual calendar and one I am sure you will want to book in your diary. The show will then be uploaded to Tapestry. More information will follow nearer the time but if you have any questions please don't hesitate to ask.
