We have read all the feedback and would like to make a few points:

- The Parent Noticeboard is situated along the passageway outside the pre-school where you queue to drop-off and collect your children. We use the noticeboard to advertise events, give you details about the childrens' snacks, and to post each monthly newsletter.
- Photographs of the members of our Management Committee are on display near the front door, alongside photographs of all members of staff.
- A suggestion was made that we might introduce uniforms, but we have always wanted to ensure that Stepping Stones Pre-school is available to everyone in the community, irrespective of their financial situation, and we do not want to pressure parents/carers into paying for a uniform which their child may only wear for a few mornings a week.

### Children's portrait photographs – are you a photographer?

Historically a local professional-photographer parent kindly volunteered a morning (and editing time) to photograph the children for individual portraits, which we then sold to raise money for Stepping Stones. It was a fantastic fundraiser and a great opportunity for our families to have some wonderful photographs of their children. Unfortunately, she is no longer able to do this for us and so we wondered if there are any other parents or friends with portrait photography skills who might be able to take over. ### Wild Science

We have booked a company called Wild Science to bring a range of 5-8 small animals to meet us on Monday 30<sup>th</sup> June (1:00pm-2:30pm) at Clipston Village Hall. They will be a mix of mammals, reptiles, amphibians and invertebrates. The last time we did this the children met a giant African snail, a lizard, a snake, a guinea pig, and a colour-changing tree frog!

The children will be divided into two groups for two half hour sessions with the animals, and the entire event will run between 1:00pm and 2:30pm. The children will also enjoy some animal crafts, games and stories.

If your child usually attends Stepping Stones on a Monday, please drop them off and pick them up from Stepping Stones at the usual times, bringing your usual packed lunch.

If your child does not usually attend on a Monday, please drop them off at Clipston Village Hall at 12:45pm and collect at 2:30pm. Please send your child already having eaten lunch.

We have not received all the permission forms yet. Please ensure that your form is returned otherwise you child will not be able to participate.

It has always been the policy for Stepping Stones to not have nuts and we currently have a child with a known nut allergy so please, please be very careful what goes into the packed lunch tomorrow and always. ### Committee – what we do and how to get involved

The setting is run by Mona Zala, the Manager, and Kelle Coulthard, Deputy Manager, and the wonderful team

Stepping Stones Pre-School is a registered charity, which is managed by a group of volunteers who form the Committee. We are legally required to have a management Committee, and without it the setting cannot legally operate. We rely heavily on, and are very grateful for, the goodwill and dedication of our volunteers.

There are lots of ways you can contribute to the Committee, and the great thing is you don't need any previous experience to make a difference. Research has shown clear benefits when parents are actively involved in their child's learning and development from an early age. Volunteering for your preschool's Committee offers an ideal opportunity for you to become more involved, both actively and practically, in this aspect of your child's life. It will also make a real difference to how your child's setting is managed.

The Committee members are the charity Trustees of the Pre-School and together they are responsible for the overall management and smooth running of the pre-school.

Three essential Committee roles, which have to be filled each year (according to Charity Commission legislation) are Chairperson, Treasurer, and Secretary. The charity must have a minimum of 5 Trustee volunteers in total. Other roles include Health & Safety, Safeguarding, and Staff Liaison.

There is a sub-Committee of volunteers who meet to organise Fundraising events. Fundraising is a vital part of supporting the charity.

In building new partnerships with other parents and professionals, the Committee come up with and implement new fundraising ideas, getting exciting plans off the ground.

Examples of things that we have been discussing in recent Committee meetings:

- Fundraising: Clipston Music Festival discussing logistics for the day, in which the Committee
  and volunteers will be serving refreshments and providing other activities to raise money for the
  Pre-School
- Fundraising: the Summer Draw: collating the prizes, finalising and printing the raffle tickets, discussing advertising
- End of Year celebrations: finalising plans for the End of Year Show and Party

You will personally benefit from joining the Committee by meeting other parents, updating existing skills, and also learning new ones, as well as putting something positive back into your local community and supporting your child's development.

We are hoping to hold an informal get-together at the beginning of the September term, giving us all a chance to meet and chat. Please look out for further information.

If you feel unable to join the Committee but would like to participate in other ways, we welcome parents into the setting who can share their skills and expertise with the children. In the past this has included playing instruments, bringing in sheep, sharing aspects of other cultures, or explaining jobs such as being a policeman. Please speak to a member of staff if you have any ideas you would like to share. You will be very welcome!
